

Rattly noise - driver's side front?

You will need

- Glue
- Rubber Pieces

Do you have a metallic rattle coming from the driver's side front of the car when going over rough roads? Don't think that it's anything significant like suspension problems or similar because it is most likely the bonnet hold-up arm rattling against the chassis.



Check the area marked in the picture and you'll probably see that the paint is worn away here. To fix it, simply glue some pieces of rubber (or similar material) to the area and the rattle stops. Simple.
